APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

Students attending University, College or a Trade school in the 2018 - 2019 academic year may be eligible for a bursary of \$1,000.00 from the St. Vincent and Grenadines Association of Toronto.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, the applicant must meet the following conditions:

- a) Applicants should not be older than 29 years of age;
- b) Their parents, grandparents or guardians should be of St. Vincent and the Grenadines descent;
- c) Be either a Financial/Honorary Life Member of the St. Vincent and Grenadines Association of Toronto Inc.;
- d) Be a first year or continuing student enrolled at or currently attending a university, college or trade school in Canada or the United States.

Proof of acceptance/enrolment to university or college or trade school must be submitted along with the application.

EVALUATION WILL BE BASED UPON:

1. Two letters of reference, one from an academic institution attended within the last year of application; and the other from a community member other than a parent.
2. An essay of approximately 500 words (in the student's own words) on one of the two following topics:
 - a) The History (Heritage and Culture) of St. Vincent and the Grenadines;
 - b) The main tourist attractions of St. Vincent and the Grenadines.
3. The applicant(s) should also outline his/her academic achievements, any volunteer involvement/community achievements and relevant information identifying financial need.

Recipient(s) must attend the Annual Independence Anniversary Gala to receive the award and serve as role a model for others in the SVG Community.
