APPLY FOR A BURSARY IN SVGAT'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students attending a University, College, or a Trade school in the 2025 - 2026 academic year may be eligible for a bursary of \$1,000.00 from the St. Vincent and Grenadines Association of Toronto.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, the applicant must meet the following conditions:

a) They, or their parents (including adoptive parents), grandparents, or guardians, should be of St. Vincent and the Grenadines descent.

b) Be a student enrolled at a recognized university, college, or trade school in Canada or the United States. Proof of enrolment to a university or college, or trade school, must be submitted along with the application.

c) All applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents or the holders of a valid student visa issued to the applicant by Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) and be residents of Ontario.

d) All applicants must demonstrate academic excellence, financial need, and community involvement.

EVALUATION WILL BE BASED UPON:

 An essay of approximately 700 words* on the following topic: Discuss what you plan to study and how it can benefit the Vincentian or Black Canadian community.

Essay Criteria

No more than 750 words or approximately 4 pages double-spaced Font must be Times New Roman in size 12.

- 2. A resume outlining the applicant's academic achievements should also address any relevant work or volunteer, or community involvements and achievements. All resumes should be in Times New Roman font in size 12.
- 3. A one-page cover letter detailing why the applicant should be considered for this scholarship. All cover letters should be in Times New Roman font in size 12.
- 4. Two Letters of Recommendation, one of which must be academic.

CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATION: All documents must be received by **September 15, 2025.** All applications must be emailed to <u>svgat@vincytoronto.com</u> in one (1) PDF-formatted document.
